StellerVista Credit Union Marks National Day for Truth and Reconciliation with Local Contributions

British Columbia: September 30, 2025 – Kootenay & Boundary, BC – September 30, 2025 — StellerVista Credit Union will be observing the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation by closing all branches and contributing a total of \$4,000 to local Indigenous-led initiatives across the region.

In the West Kootenay Boundary, a donation of \$2,000 has been made to COINS (Circle of Indigenous Nations Society), and in the East Kootenay, \$2,000 has been contributed to Operation Street Angel (Ktunaxa Nation Council). Both organizations provide vital programs and supports that strengthen cultural connections and community well-being.

“This day is an important time to pause, reflect, and acknowledge the ongoing journey of truth and reconciliation,” said Jody Burk, CEO of StellerVista Credit Union. “Our contributions are a small way to support organizations doing meaningful work in our communities, while ensuring we also take the time to listen and learn.”
