\$50,000 in StellerImpact Grants Awarded to Local Groups in the Kootenay and Boundary regions this Credit Union Day

Kootenay / Boundary, BC: October 16th – Twenty different non-profit community groups and initiatives in the Kootenay and Boundary regions have been awarded a StellerImpact community grant, ranging from \$1,000 to \$5,000 – totaling more than \$50,000.

The grant program, now in its third year, supports community-focused projects in the areas served by StellerVista Credit Union, including Cranbrook, Castlegar, Fernie, Sparwood, Elkford, the Slocan Valley, and the West Boundary.

"Every day, people and organizations in our communities are rolling up their sleeves to create positive change," says Jody Burk, CEO of StellerVista Credit Union. It's inspiring to see the variety and creativity of the projects being led by local groups."
